The Green Leaf Inn is a 19 unit luxury Inn being developed in the Lake Geneva WI area that will be a net zero energy campus setting on an annualized basis. The Inn will be a demonstration center showing sustainable building systems and integrated renewable energy systems including wind, solar thermal (three different types), solar electric (roof mount and dual axis tracking), geothermal, biomass gasifier and rainwater capture and reuse.
